INTRODUCTION

A wide range of investment and funding programmes exist for the research, development, demonstration and deployment of new and renewable energy technologies. However, as each programme is run and promoted by discrete organisations with limited coordination between the various providers and contractors, it is complex and difficult for those wishing to obtain funding to access the appropriate programme to suit their needs.

AIM

The purpose of the information day is to provide a comprehensive overview of the private and public investment and funding opportunities available to those wishing to research, develop, demonstrate and deploy new and renewable energy technologies.

TARGET AUDIENCE

The event will provide valuable information for:

- Project and technology developers;
- Project and technology investors (e.g. Angel Investors, Banks, High Net Worth Individuals, Venture Capitalists).
- Energy utilities;
- Large energy users in the public and private sectors (i.e. those wishing to deploy new and renewable energy technologies); and
- Business support organisations and industry / trade associations.

OBJECTIVES

The information day will:

- Provide an opportunity for those seeking funding to identify the right programme(s) and/or investor(s) to meet their needs;
- Provide an opportunity for private sector investors to identify high quality project and technology development investment opportunities;
- Enable technology and project developers to plan ahead to match their research, development, demonstration and deployment needs with the various priorities and deadlines associated with the funding programmes;
- Stimulate networking and partnerships between private and public sector organisations and individuals involved in energy technology research, development, demonstration, deployment and investment; and
- Help funding providers and their contractors to signpost technology and project developers to the appropriate programmes if their own programmes are not suitable.

- Demonstration and Project Deployment; and
- Knowledge Transfer.
